

# Fold Back Pop Up Way to Goat



## Supplies

- Stamps: Way to Goat (152657)
- Ink: Black Tuxedo (132708)
- Paper:
  - Pear Pizzazz (131201): card base 8 1/2" x 5 1/2", scored at 2 1/8" and 4 1/4"
  - Crushed Curry (131199): cut two 2-3/4" squares ) and two 1-3/4" square for card front
  - Very Vanilla (101650): cut two 2-1/2" squares p) and two 1-1/2" squares for card front
  - Cinnamon Cider (153078) scrap for fence
  - 1st DSP: cut two at 1 7/8" x 5 1/4" and one 4" x 5-1/4"
  - 2nd DSP: 2" square then cut at diagonal for corners of base
- Tools: Birthday Chick Die (158200); Paper Trimmer (152392)
- Other: Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

## Instructions:

1. Score and fold card base
2. Open the card flat and adhere #1 DSP to the 3 panels
3. Cut the #2 DSP diagonal to make 2 triangles and adhere to the corners on inside right
4. Layer one Curry 2-3/4" square and 2-1/2" Vanilla square
5. Scored the other 2-3/4" Curry square in half from point to point and then cut 1/2" off parallel to one side of diagonal for center pop up
6. Glue center flap to center panel - tab side back
7. Cut the other 2-1/2" Vanilla square in half point to point for center pop up
8. Stamp sentiments on a half Vanilla triangle and adhere to center flap piece created in step 5
9. Layer 2 smaller Curry and Vanilla squares and adhere only half to the first panel on point for card front
10. Stamp, color and cut out goats
11. Adhere 2 goats to layered squares on front of card
12. Create scene with standing goat and fence and sentiment on 2-3/4" curry/Vanilla layer square
13. adhere layered square centered between the DSP triangles.
